Per Licensing Requirements for Family Child Care Homes and Large Family Child Care Homes, Requirements for caregivers (Oklahoma Administrative Code 340:110-3-85), prior to caring for children, all caregivers obtain training in:

- prevention and control of infectious disease and injury prevention measures
- use of a fire extinguisher
- prevention of shaken baby syndrome and abusive head trauma
- prevention of sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS)
- infant safe sleep practices
- car seat and transportation safety
- physical premise safety including identification of and protection from hazards that can cause bodily injury such as, electrical hazards, bodies of water, or vehicular traffic
- handling and storage of hazardous materials and appropriate disposal of bio-contaminants
- emergency preparedness and response planning for emergencies resulting from a natural disaster or human-caused event
- immunizations
- administration of medication
- prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions
- the definition, identification, and mandatory reporting of child abuse and neglect
- behavior and guidance methods
- child development
